

ORDINANCE 956

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, TEXAS, BY DELETING THE EXISTING SUBSECTION (1) FROM SECTION §74-245 AND SUBSTITUTING THEREFORE A NEW SUBSECTION (1); PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO CONSTRUCT OR INSTALL A MAIL BOX WHICH IS: (A) GREATER THAN 30" WIDE AT THE SIDE RUNNING PARALLEL TO THE STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY X 36" DEEP AND (B) EXCEEDS 66" ABOVE THE NATURAL GRADE; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000.00 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Piney Point Village, Texas, is hereby amended by substituting a new Subsection (a) of Section 74-245 thereof and substituting therefore a new Subsection (b) to provide as follows:

“(1) *Mail Boxes.* It shall be unlawful for any person to construct or install a mail box which is greater than 30” wide at the side running parallel to the street right-of-way, 36” deep, and exceeds 66” above the ground on which it is located.”

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City council of the City of Piney Point Village, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts..
